laws of this state, whose members consist wholly of farmers; provided, no pecuniary profit results to any individual member.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section 40.45 of the statutes, relating to training course for teachers in high schools.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (3) of section 40.45 of the statutes is amended to read: (40.45) (3) Any person who shall complete such course of study, and who shall be of good moral character, shall receive a certificate, signed by the principal of such school and by the school board, setting forth that the person therein named has satisfactorily completed the course of study prescribed, and is of good moral character, and giving the standings secured by the person in each of the studies in the course. This course shall be open to nonresident students on the terms provided for nonresident attendance under the provisions of subsection (1) of section 41.46.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
