journal clerk and index clerk of the next succeeding legislature applying therefor; not exceeding ten copies each to the state library, the state historical society, the university library, the university law library and the library of the legislative reference department; one copy each to all other public libraries applying therefor. The copies printed on bond paper shall be delivered to the respective chief clerks. Each chief clerk shall, upon request, be supplied for use during the session, with the journals of any previous session of the legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT to create section 29.202 of the statutes, relating to close season in Spring or Miracle creek, Jefferson county.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read: 29.202 No person shall take, catch or kill any fish in Spring creek, also known as Miracle creek, and its tributaries, in sections seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-seven, twentyeight, twenty-nine, thirty-two and thirty-three, in the town of Palmyra, county of Jefferson, for a period of four years after the date of the enactment of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
