CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT to create paragraph (n) of subsection (1) of section 16.33 and subsection (3) of section 59.46 of the statutes, relating to investigators in the office of the district attorney in certain counties.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly; do enact as follows:

Section 1. A new paragraph is added to subsection (1) of section 16.33 and a new subsection is added to section 59.46 of the statutes to read: (16.33) (1) (n) Investigators in the office of the district attorney, when authorized by the county board.

(59.46) (3) The district attorney of any county containing a city of the first class may appoint such investigators as may be authorized by the county board, and the county board may abolish such positions at their pleasure. Such investigators when so appointed shall have general police powers within said county.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 254.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein specified as an emergency appropriation to the executive department.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the executive department as an emergency appropriation for the year ending June 30, 1929, one thousand dollars in addition to the appropriations to said department made in section 20.02 of the statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
