for the accommodation of patrons of such hotels, or such motor vehicles as are used or operated exclusively in transporting or delivering dairy or other farm products or agricultural or horticultural products from the point of production to the primary market, or * * motor vehicles employed exclusively in transporting or delivering property or freight within any city or village in this state or between contiguous villages or cities, or a motor vehicle operated by a merchant having his place of business in a town or village which has no railway station, where such vehicle is operated solely between such place of business and a railway station and primarily for the transportation of his own goods, and there is no transportation company operating between such town or village and railway station.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 272.

AN ACT to create subsection (24) of section 69.33 of the statutes, relating to death certificates.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 69.33 of the statutes to read: (69.33) (24) Statement whether or not the deceased served in the military or naval forces of the United States.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
