CHAPTER 298.

AN ACT to create subsection (9) of section 72.01 of the statutes, relating to reciprocity in inheritance taxes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 72.01 of the statutes to read: (72.01) (9) Personal property of a nonresident decedent made taxable under this chapter, except tangible personal property having an actual situs in this state, shall not be subject to the tax so imposed if a like exemption was allowed at the time of death of such decedent by the laws of the state, territory or district of the decedent's residence in favor of residents of this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
