CHAPTER 463.

AN ACT to repeal subsection (4) and to amend subsection (1) of section 20.19 and subsection (2) of section 24.04, and to create section 20.191 of the statutes, relating to the commissioners of public lands and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 20.19 of the statutes is repealed.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 20.19 and subsection (2) of section 24.04 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.19) (1) Annually, beginning July 1, * * 1929, * * nine thousand dollars, for the execution of their functions.

(24.04) (2) All expenses necessarily incurred in caring for and selling public lands shall be paid out of the * * appropriation made in subsection (1) of section 20.19.

Section 3. A new section is added to the statutes to read: 20.191 There is appropriated to the commissioners of public lands from the income of the trust funds to which the lands administered by the commissioners belong, on July 1, 1929, fifteen thousand dollars, and on July 1, 1930, fifteen thousand dollars, for an inventory and survey of all lands under their jurisdiction. This appropriation shall be chargeable to the income of each trust fund administered by the commissioners of public lands to the extent of the expenditure on the lands belonging to such trust fund.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
