natural history survey shall receive no compensation for their services.

CHAPTER 511.

AN ACT continuing the interim committee on the investigation of prison labor conditions, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

The interim committee appointed in accordance with the provisions of chapter 354 of the laws of 1927 to investigate prison labor conditions is hereby continued with all of its powers and duties and there is appropriated the unexpended balance of the appropriation made by section 2, chapter 354 of the laws of 1927, to such committee to enable it to complete its work.
