purchase from the lowest reliable bidder. • • • In counties having a population of two hundred fifty thousand or more, purchases shall be made as the county board shall direct, and in addition to the county officers previously named, purchases may be made for the office of the county surveyor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 87.01 of the statutes, relating to town bridges.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 87.01 of the statutes is amended to read: (87.01) (2) If the town has an assessed valuation of four hundred thousand dollars or over as last equalized by the county board, the county shall pay the costs in excess of two hundred dollars up to four hundred dollars. The town and county shall each pay one-half of the cost of construction or repair above four hundred dollars. If the town has an equalized assessed valuation of less than four hundred thousand dollars, the county shall pay the cost in excess of one-twentieth of one per cent of said valuation until the cost equals one-tenth of one per cent of said valuation. The town and county shall each pay onehalf of the cost of such construction or repair in excess of onetenth of one per cent of said valuation of the town. mining the cost of construction or repair of any bridge, the cost of constructing or repairing any approach not exceeding one hundred feet in length shall be * included.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
