CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT to amend section 146.085 of the statutes, relating to the enforcement of the said section, and providing a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 146.085 of the statutes is amended to read: 146.085 If the owner or manager of any public building, as defined in subsection (1) of section 101.01, shall keep more than fifty per centum of the toilet compartment of any public toilet room locked, he shall be fined not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars. *It shall be the duty of the state board of health, the industrial commission and the railroad commission to enforce the provisions of this section within their respective jurisdictions.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT to amend section 67.19 of the statutes, relating to re-funding of city or village debt.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 67.19 of the statutes is amended to read: 67.19 The governing body of any city or village may provide for raising money necessary to pay and discharge any indebtedness owing by it, due and unpaid on December 31, * * * 1930. If it is desired to pay such indebtedness by the issuing of bonds or other evidence of indebtedness, the procedure shall be as provided in section 67.05 for the issue of any other municipal bonds.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
