

SECTION 1. Section 62.195 of the statutes is amended to read:
 62.195 * * * In addition to other methods provided by law, the common council of any city of the second, third or fourth class, or the village board of any village, may by ordinance provide that the cost of installing, constructing or laying storm sewers wholly or partially in any street, *alley* or highway, or in any lot or parcel of land, sanitary sewers, water mains, paving or any other public improvement to be installed along or in any street, *alley* or highway, or across or in any lot or parcel of land in such city or village, shall be charged in whole or in part to the property benefited thereby, and to make an assessment against such property in such manner as such council or village board may determine.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

AN ACT to amend subsection (6) of section 29.19 of the statutes, relating to open season for pickerel.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (6) of section 29.19 of the statutes is amended to read: (29.19) (6) Pickerel:

(a) <i>In Lake Beulah in Walworth county:</i>	<i>June 20 to</i>	<i>Ten each</i>	<i>16 inches</i>
	<i>March 1</i>	<i>day</i>	
(b) <i>In all other waters</i>	<i>May 25 to</i>	<i>Ten each</i>	<i>16 inches</i>
	<i>March 1</i>	<i>day</i>
