CHAPTER 318.

AN ACT appropriating a sum therein named to the legislature for contingent expenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

In addition to the appropriation made by subsection (10) of section 20.01 of the statutes, there is appropriated from the general fund to the legislature, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941, for contingent expenses of the senate and assembly, \$500 for the senate and \$1,000 for the assembly, subject to the conditions provided in paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) of subsection (10) of section 20.01 of the statutes.

CHAPTER 319.

AN ACT to amend 14.445 of the statutes, relating to investments by the board of deposits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 14.445 of the statutes is amended to SECTION 1. read:

14.445 Whenever the board of deposits may deem it advisable, it may and it is hereby authorized to invest in, hold and dispose of readily salable interest bearing bonds of the United States, the state of Wisconsin, and interest bearing bonds which are a direct obligation of any county, * * * city * * * or village in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
