proceeding within the purview of the foregoing provision shall be extended by reason of any fact and for the time specified in sections 330.30 to 330.38, except that no person who has filed with the secretary of state or the department or any other department or commission of this state which at any time had jurisdiction over the sale of securities in this state, an appointment of a resident of this state as attorney upon whom process may be served shall be deemed, for any purpose, to be or from the date of such appointment to have been a person out of this state under section 330.30.
