## CHAPTER 53.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to the Military Order of the World War National Convention.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the Military Order of the World War National Convention of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, the sum of \$500, for the purpose of defraying a portion of the expenses of a convention to be held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in the summer of 1942. Such sum shall be paid on July 1, 1942 to the then acting secretary and treasurer of such Military Order of the World War National Convention.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT to amend 202.08 (2) of the statutes, relating to premium rates of town mutual insurance companies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 202.08 of the statutes is amended to read: (202.08) (2) The board or the company may classify property under different rates, corresponding as nearly as may be to the greater or less risk which may attach to such property, and may establish premium rates to be charged on various classifications. A rate once established shall not be changed within one year. \* \* \* A schedule of the rates and all changes thereof shall be filed with the commissioner of insurance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
