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* * * The sworn statement of the collection and deportation counsel of the state * * * department of public welfare, or the superintendent of such institution, for the purpose of showing the names, time in the institution, and the actual per capita cost of maintenance furnished, shall be prima facie evidence of such facts. The state * * * department of public welfare shall make adjustment with the several counties, for their proper share of all moneys recovered, in the settlement with the counties provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and

publication.

CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 194.47 (4) of the statutes, relating to the exemption of certain motor vehicles from quarterly flat tax and mileage tax as provided by sections 194.48 and 194.49.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (4) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read: (194.47) (4) All motor vehicles equipped with dump bodies while engaged exclusively in the transportation of dirt, sand, gravel, stone, asphalt, cinders, ashes, or cement for highway and building construction and maintenance, not
