CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to amend 253.07 (1) of the statutes, relating to affidavits of prejudice in county courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 253.07 of the statutes is amended by adding at the end thereof the following: "In any such matter, order, citation, or proceedings no party shall be allowed to file an affidavit against more than one judge."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to create 36.06 (8) of the statutes, relating to additional powers of the regents of the university of Wisconsin, and providing penalties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (8) of section 36.06 of the statutes is created to read:

(36.06) (8) In so far as they can be made applicable to the lands owned by or under the control of the regents all special powers conferred on the conservation commission by subsections (2) and (3) of section 27.01 are conferred upon the regents, and all penalties set forth or referred to in said subsections apply with equal force and effect to this subsection.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
