CHAPTER 238.

AN ACT to amend 142.03 (1) of the statutes, relating to cost of investigations for application to the Wisconsin General Hospital.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

142.03 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

142.03 (1) The application shall contain a full statement of the financial situation of the person and a general statement of his physical condition, and shall be verified. The county judge, or any person he designates, shall make investigation and the supervisor for the town, village or ward of the legal settlement of the person shall supply to the court, on request all material information within his knowledge and no compensation or expense shall be paid or allowed by the county to any supervisor supplying such material information.
