schools and the local school clerk as being due and payable for the operation and maintenance of the school for the current school year in which the loan is made. All such loans shall be secured by lawfully authorized and drawn school orders, each order when paid to be receipted and returned to the treasurer of the board.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to amend 39.15 (1) of the statutes, relating to teachers' certificates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

39.15 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

39.15 (1) If any person desires to teach in any of the * * * public schools, or in schools maintained and operated by county homes for dependent children or other county or state institutions or schools in which children are received for care or education, he shall procure a certificate from the state superintendent.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to create 40.04 (14) of the statutes, relating to emergency powers of school boards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.04 (14) of the statutes is created to read:

40.04 (14) Emergencies. In case of destruction of school district buildings, the school board may, on its own order, provide for the educational needs of the district on a tuition basis.
