CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT to amend 272.18 (23) of the statutes, relating to the exemption of war bonds from execution.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

272.18 (23) of the statutes is amended to read:

272.18 (23) All * * * defense bonds, war savings bonds, defense stamps, thrift stamps, war savings stamps, * * * victory notes, * * * or any other governmental issue of bonds or savings stamps for war purposes, held by any person, to the value of \$200 in the aggregate.

CHAPTER 88.

AN ACT to create 40.47 (4a) of the statutes, relating to high school tuition.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.47 (4a) of the statutes is created to read:

40.47 (4a) OTHER TUITION. The board of any school district which operates a high school may contract with the university extension division of the university of Wisconsin for extension courses for pupils enrolled in such high schools. The cost of such contract shall be paid out of school district funds and shall be included in the cost of operation and maintenance of the high school districts which enter into such contract for the purpose of computing tuition costs.
