### CHAPTER 96.

AN ACT to create 40.19 (1a) of the statutes, relating to contracts of teachers of agricultural and homemaking courses.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

40.19 (1a) of the statutes is created to read:

40.19 (1a) School district boards may provide in the contracts of teachers of agricultural and homemaking courses for payment for services performed outside of the district and connected with the performance of their regular teaching duties, and for the payment of the traveling expenses connected with such services out of school district funds.

### CHAPTER 97.

AN ACT to amend 186.19 (1) of the statutes, relating to surety bonds of officers of credit unions.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

186.19 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

186.19 (1) Every person appointed or elected to any position requiring the receipt, payment or custody of money or other personal property belonging to a credit union, shall, within 30 days after such appointment or election, give a bond in some good and responsible corporate surety company *licensed to do business in the state of Wisconsin*, in such sums as the directors shall require and approve. All such bonds shall be in the form prescribed by the banking commission.
