CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to create 41.15 (13) of the statutes, relating to powers and duties of local boards of vocational and adult education in cities of the first class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.15 (13) of the statutes is created to read:

41.15 (13) Effective June 1, 1945, any teacher and any director heretofore or hereafter coming under the provisions of section 41.15 (12) who has attained or shall attain the age of 70 years shall be retired by the local board at the end of the school year in which he reaches the age of 70. A school year shall begin on July 1 in any year and end on June 30 of the following year.

CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to create 59.08 (49) of the statutes, relating to county aid to vocational and adult education schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.08 (49) of the statutes is created to read:

59.08 (49) VOCATIONAL AND ADULT EDUCATION SCHOOLS. To appropriate money to be paid to local boards of vocational and adult education which render services to residents of the county. Supervisors from any city or village maintaining a school pursuant to section 41.15 shall have no part in any determination under this subsection and no part of any expense incurred under this subsection shall be levied against any property within any such city or village.
