CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to amend 256.40 of the statutes, relating to the authority of the circuit judge to purchase law books for any county in his circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

256.40 of the statutes is amended to read:

256.40 Any circuit judge may, whenever he shall deem it desirable, purchase or direct the clerk of the circuit court for any county in his circuit to purchase law books and subscribe for the periodical reports of any of the courts of the several states or territories or of the United States, for any county in his circuit, provided the cost of such books and reports shall not exceed * * * \$500 for any county in one year, unless the board of supervisors of such county shall authorize the expenditure of a larger sum. Whenever such purchase or subscription shall be made such clerk shall have each volume of books received stamped or branded with the name of his county and keep the same in his office for the use of the courts, judges, attorneys and officers thereof. Such clerk shall be responsible for their safe-keeping and shall, at the expiration of his term, deliver them to his successor, take a receipt therefor and file it in the office of the county clerk. The cost of such volumes shall be paid by the county treasurer upon the presentation to him of the accounts therefor, certified to by the clerk of the circuit court and the circuit judge.

CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT to create 59.08 (51) of the statutes, relating to the compensation of the members of the county park commission for attendance at meetings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.08 (51) of the statutes is created to read:

59.08 (51) COUNTY PARK COMMISSION. Except in

counties of a population of 500,000 or more, fix the compensation of members of the county park commission for attendance upon meetings at a rate not to exceed \$5 per day.

CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT to create 47.01 (3) of the statutes, relating to changing the name of the Wisconsin school for the blind to the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

47.01 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

47.01 (3) The name of the Wisconsin school for the blind is changed to the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped. The revisor of statutes is directed to make the necessary changes in the language of the statutes so as to indicate the change of name provided for in this subsection.

CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT to authorize the state department of public welfare to purchase certain lands in Winnebago county and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The department of public welfare is authorized to purchase 14 acres, more or less, of land in Winnebago county, adjoining Winnebago state hospital lands, at not to exceed \$250 per acre for the sum of not exceeding \$3500, described as follows, to wit: 14 acres in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 19 north, range 16 east. The money to be expended for the purchase of such land shall be charged to the revolving appropriation made to the department in section 20.175 (1) of the statutes. Such purchase shall be subject to the approval of the governor.
