CHAPTER 275.

AN ACT to create 60.29 (18m) of the statutes, relating to fire protection in towns and liability of towns for fire fighting service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

60.29 (18m) of the statutes is created to read:

60.29 (18m) TOWNS WITHOUT FIRE PROTECTION LIABLE FOR FIRE FIGHTING SERVICE. Any town failing to provide under subsection (18) or otherwise for a fire department and fire fighting apparatus and equipment for extinguishing fires in such towns shall be liable for the services of a fire department in fighting fire and appearing to fight fire in such town upon request.

CHAPTER 276.

AN ACT to create 41.375 of the statutes, relating to university extension courses for county normal school students.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.375 of the statutes is created to read:

41.375 SAME; EXTENSION COURSES FOR STUDENTS. The county normal school board may contract with the university extension division of the university of Wisconsin for extension courses for pupils enrolled in county normal schools.
