### CHAPTER 386.

AN ACT to amend 70.11 (15) of the statutes, relating to exemption from taxation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

70.11 (15) of the statutes is amended to read:

70.11 (15) All the real and personal property of any \* \* \* children's institution licensed for the care of dependent, neglected or delinquent children under sections 48.35 to 48.42 while the same is actually used for such purposes, and the real estate of the Home of the Friendless in the city of Milwaukee, not exceeding one lot, while the same \* \* \* is actually used for such home \* \* \* \* \*

### CHAPTER 387.

AN ACT to create 70.11 (44) of the statutes, relating to the exemption from taxation of property of volunteer firemen's associations.

70.11 (44) All the property of volunteer firemen associations duly organized under chapter 213.
