CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to amend 59.04 (2) of the statutes, relating to notice required for special meetings of the county board of supervisors in counties having a population of 500,000 or more.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.04 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.04 (2) A special meeting of any county board shall be held only upon a written request of a majority of the members thereof addressed and delivered to the county clerk, and specifying the time and place of such meeting. The time shall not be less than one week from the delivery of such request to the clerk, except that in counties having a population of 500,000 or more the time shall not be less than 48 hours from delivery of such request. Upon receiving such request the county clerk shall forthwith mail to each member of the board notice of the time and place of such meeting. Any special meeting may be adjourned from time to time by a vote of a majority of all the members of the board.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to amend 161.01 (14) and to create 161.01 (13a) of the statutes, relating to the inclusion of isonipecaine in the uniform narcotic drug act.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 161.01 (13a) of the statutes is created to read:

161.01 (13a) "Isonipecaine" means the substance identified chemically as 1-methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester, or any salt thereof by whatever trade name identified.

Section 2. 161.01 (14) of the statutes is amended to read:

161.01 (14) "Narcotic drugs" means coca leaves, opium, Cannabis, isonipecaine, and every substance neither chemically nor physically distinguishable from them.
