CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT to create 246.075 of the statutes, relating to liability of wife for personal injuries to husband caused by her negligence.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

246.075 of the statutes is created to read:

246.075 LIABILITY OF WIFE FOR INJURIES TO HUSBAND. A husband shall have and may maintain an action against his wife for the recovery of damage for injuries sustained to his person caused by her wrongful act, neglect or default.
