or from the county at large. They shall have a demonstrated and recognized knowledge of and interest in public welfare. They shall serve for such terms and receive such compensation as shall be fixed by the county board of supervisors.

SECTION 3. 58.55 (10) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

58.55 (10) To administer child welfare service under and subject to the provisions of section 48.315, thereby administering the functions otherwise administered by county children's boards and licensed child welfare agencies.

CHAPTER 294.

AN ACT to amend 70.425 (1) of the statutes, relating to the occupational tax on owners of domestic mink.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

70.425 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

70.425 (1) There is imposed an annual occupational tax on every person, firm or corporation owning or operating any domestic mink farm, computed on the basis of * * * \$5 for each such farm, which tax shall be in addition to all other taxes.

CHAPTER 295.

AN ACT to authorize the conservation commission to dispose of certain park lands to the village of Cassville.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The conservation commission is empowered and authorized to sell or otherwise dispose of certain lands located in the Nelson Dewey Memorial State Park and west of the Chicago, Burling-
