CHAPTER 386.

AN ACT to create 20.41 (3) (c) of the statutes, relating to research into diseases of dogs and information on nutrition of dogs, providing funds therefor and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.41 (3) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

20.41 (3) (c) *Research on dog diseases and nutrition.* On July 1, 1947, \$6,000 and on July 1, 1948, \$6,000 for research into the causes, prevention and cure of diseases of dogs, and for the development of more adequate information on the nutrition of dogs, including purchase of equipment and supplies, construction of buildings, and such other expenditures as may be essential for the effective conduct of such research.

SECTION 2. On June 30, 1947, there shall revert to the general fund from the appropriation made by section 20.60 (11) of the statutes, the sum of \$12,000.

CHAPTER 387.

AN ACT to amend 319.48 of the statutes, relating to the sale of real estate by minor veterans and their husbands or wives and compromising notes and mortgages executed by them pursuant to said section 319.48.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

319.48 of the statutes is amended to read:

319.48 Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter or any other provision of law to the contrary, any minor who served in the active armed forces of the United States at any time between August 27, 1940, and the termination of World War II as proclaimed by the President or the Congress and the husband or wife of such minor may execute in his or her own right, notes or mortgages, the payment of which is guaranteed
