(d) The school district board of districts in counties containing less than 500,000 population, may require periodic health examinations of school children, by licensed physicians, under supervision of local and state boards of health, and may pay the cost of such examinations out of district funds.

SECTION 3. 40.53 (17) of the statutes is created to read:

40.53 (17) To provide for periodic health examinations for school employes and school children as specified in section 40.16 (14) (b), (c) and (d).

### CHAPTER 518.

AN ACT to repeal 20.491 (5), to amend 20.49 (introductory paragraph) and (9) (a), and to create 20.49 (11) of the statutes, relating to the state highway fund and state trunk highway allotment, providing for the addition of certain highways to the state trunk highway system, and making an appropriation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 20.491 (5) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. 20.49 (introductory paragraph) and (9) (a) of the statutes are amended to read:

20.49 (introductory paragraph) There is appropriated to the state highway commission as received in the state highway fund the surplus of the motor vehicle registration fees, operator's license fees, motor vehicle fuel taxes, and motor carrier fees and taxes, after deducting the actual costs of administration paid from the appropriations made by sections 20.052, 20.091 and 20.511, \* \* \*. The amount thereof collected in each fiscal year and appropriated by this section shall be apportioned and allotted by the commission in the amounts and on the dates hereinafter provided; and if no date is specified, then at such time or times during such fiscal year as the commission may determine.

(9) (a) To carry out the purposes as provided in sections 20.491 (3), 84.01 (7) and (21), 84.03 (9), 84.07, 86.24 and 20.49 (9) (b), the amount remaining after the allotments provided by subsections (1) to (8) have been set aside; *but the allotment under this subsection shall not exceed \$10,646,400 plus the amount added by subsection (11) (a).*

SECTION 2a. 20.49 (11) of the statutes is created to read:

20.49 (11) On June 30, the amount remaining after the allotments provided by subsections (1) to (9) have been set aside, which shall be apportioned and allotted as follows:

(a) Forty per cent shall be added to the allotment provided by subsection (9).

(b) Sixty per cent shall be apportioned and allotted to the several counties, towns, villages, and cities as follows:

1. To supplement the appropriation to counties made by sections 20.49 (3) and 83.10 a sum equal to 30 per cent of such revenues.

2. To all towns to supplement the appropriation made by subsection (8) a sum equal to 30 per cent of such revenues, to be allocated to each town in proportion to the allotment under subsection (8).

3. To all villages to supplement the appropriation made by subsection (8) a sum equal to 10 per cent of such revenues, to be allocated to each village in proportion to the allotment under subsection (8).

4. To all cities to supplement the appropriation made by subsection (8) a sum equal to 30 per cent of such revenues, to be allocated to each city in proportion to the allotment under subsection (8).

(c) The appropriations made by subsection (11) (b) shall be paid in the same manner as each appropriation so supplemented. The first allocation shall be for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947 and shall be made on July 15, 1947 or as soon thereafter as subsection (11) (b) becomes effective.

SECTION 3. The state highway commission is directed to add to the state trunk highway system the following highways or

SECTION 4. The state highway commission is directed to remove from the state trunk highway system a highway extending

from United States highway 141 at Crivitz in Marinette county, southeasterly on state trunk highway 158 to its junction with state trunk highway 64, a total of approximately 12 miles.

SECTION 5. In addition to the mileage specified in SECTION 3, the state highway commission is authorized to add to the state trunk highway system additional mileage to a total of not to exceed 145 miles, making a total addition of not to exceed 1,000 miles.

SECTION 6. Sections 1 to 4 inclusive shall take effect at the close of business on June 30, 1947, and shall apply to the distribution of the revenues of the fiscal year ending on that date.

### CHAPTER 519.

AN ACT to consolidate, renumber and revise chapters 53, 54 and 55 of the statutes, relating to prisons.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapters 53, 54 and 55 of the statutes are consolidated, renumbered chapter 53 and revised to read:

#### CHAPTER 53

#### PRISONS; STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL

53.01 NAMES OF PRISONS. The penitentiary at Waupun is named "Wisconsin State Prison." The penitentiary at Taycheedah, formerly known as the Wisconsin industrial home for women and the Wisconsin prison for women, is named "Wisconsin Home for Women." The penitentiary at Green Bay is named "Wisconsin State Reformatory." The institutions named in this section are state prisons.

53.02 JURISDICTION AND EXTENT OF STATE PRISONS; SERVICE OF PROCESS THEREIN. (1) WISCONSIN STATE PRISON. For all purposes of discipline and for judicial proceedings, the Wisconsin state prison and the precincts thereof shall be deemed to be in Dodge county, and the courts of that county shall have jurisdiction of all crimes committed within the same. Every activity conducted under the jurisdiction of
