written request of a majority of the members of such board, to such a day as is designated in such request, but not less than one week nor more than 3 weeks from the said Tuesday next succeeding the said Monday of November. Upon such adjournment being made, such clerk shall give each member of the board written notice of the time to which the annual meeting has been adjourned.

CHAPTER 542.

AN ACT to amend 40.03 (4) of the statutes, relating to special school district meetings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.03 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

40.03 (4) Special meetings to transact any business properly within the powers of the annual district meeting as provided in section 40.04 shall be called by the clerk, or, in his absence, by the director or treasurer, on the written request of 5 electors, or may be called by the board on its own motion, and notice thereof, specifying particularly the business to be transacted, shall be given in the manner prescribed for noticing the annual meeting. If the request for such special meeting includes any subject beyond the power of the district meeting to transact, the clerk shall reject such subject and notify each elector signing the request.
