Such committee shall give consideration to the practical operation and application of this subchapter and may make recommendations with respect to amendments of this subchapter and shall report to the proper legislative committee its view on any pending bill relating to this subchapter. Regular meetings of such committee shall be held on the first Monday of each alternate month following the effective date of this amendment (1947). Special meetings of the committee may be called at other times by the board. Members of the advisory committee shall receive no salary or compensation for service on said committee, but shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses.

## CHAPTER 89.

AN ACT to amend 41.13 (4) of the statutes, relating to vocational and adult education.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.13 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

41.13 (4) The board shall co-operate with the \* \* \* United States office of education and the federal government in the execution of the provisions of the United States vocational education act and any federal statutes pertaining to vocational education and amendatory or supplementary acts thereto, and is hereby empowered with full authority so to co-operate. The state treasurer is hereby designated custodian of all funds allotted to this state from the appropriations made by said act, and he shall receive and provide for the proper custody and disbursement of the same in accordance with said \* \* \* federal statutes.
