JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to memorializing Congress to raise the amount of personal exemptions on federal taxation of incomes.

WHEREAS, Congress has expressed the desire to relieve the tax burden on individuals subject to income tax; and

WHEREAS, The amount of the exemptions was lowered at or near the commencement of World War II so as to increase revenues for that war; and

WHEREAS, The increase of the amount of exemptions will not materially decrease the amount of revenue from taxes on individual incomes but will relieve the burden upon persons in the low income groups; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the Assembly, the Senate concurring, That Congress is hereby memorialized to enact legislation raising the amount of the personal exemptions in the federal income tax law; be it further

Resolved, That duly attested copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States, to each house of Congress and to each Wisconsin member thereof.
