CHAPTER 158.

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 59.07 (22) of the statutes, relating to national forest crop income.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.07 (22) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

59.07 (22) The treasurer of each county receiving national forest income shall make distribution thereof to the towns in the county wherein national forest lands are situated, each town to receive such proportion thereof as the area of national forest lands therein bears to the area of such lands in the entire county. Fifty percent of the amount received by it shall be expended by the town exclusively for the benefit of roads therein and the remaining 50 per cent thereof shall be allotted by the town treasurer, in such equitable manner as the town board shall determine, to school districts in the town for school purposes.
