## CHAPTER 176.

AN ACT to amend 192.53 (3) of the statutes, relating to railroad track clearance of certain platforms.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

192.53 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

192.53 (3) High platforms in existence on July 1, 1949 for handling baggage, mail, express and freight to and from cars on other than main tracks, where an unobstructed working space at ground level is maintained on the opposite side of track from such platform, may be \* \* \* maintained with face or edge 5 feet 8 inches from center line of such track, but after July 1, 1949, no such platform shall be constructed which provides a clearance of less than 6 feet 4 inches between the face or edge thereof and the center line of any such track. No such platform shall be constructed which is more than 5 feet above top of rail level.
