CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT to create 35.095 and to amend the first sentence of 35.15 of the statutes, relating to chapter numbers of the session laws.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 35.095 of the statutes is created to read:

35.095 CHAPTER NUMBERING OF ACTS. At the time the governor approves a bill (an act) he shall give it a chapter number. The acts of a session shall be numbered consecutively commencing with 1. If a bill is passed over the governor's veto the chief clerk of the house of its origin shall immediately give the bill its proper chapter number.

SECTION 2. The first sentence of 35.15 of the statutes is amended to read:

35.15 (First sentence) Immediately after the end of each general and each special session of the legislature, * * the secretary of state * * *shall* prepare printer's copy for a volume denominated "Wisconsin Session Laws," which shall contain all acts * * *enacted* during such * * session, * * * all memorials and important resolutions of the * * session, and an alphabetical index * * to the volume * * prepared by the revisor.
