CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT to amend 157.03 (7) of the statutes, relating to towns contributing towards the maintenance of a cemetery, located wholly within a town, having buried therein decedents from such towns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

157.03 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

157.03 (7) When a cemetery association having control of a cemetery in a town, has insufficient maintenance funds it may certify in writing to the town clerk the amount deemed necessary during the next ensuing year, the amount the association has therefor, and the deficiency, and the town board may levy and collect a tax therefor and pay the same to the association. If the cemetery is in more than one town the deficiency shall be equitably distributed. If a cemetery located wholly within a town has also buried therein decedents from another town, the association having insufficient funds, the association may certify in writing to its town clerk and to the town clerk of such other town, the amount deemed necessary for the ensuing year, the amount the association has therefor, the amount of the deficiency and the equitable amount that each town should contribute; whereupon the town board of each such town may levy and collect a tax therefor and pay the same to the association.
