CHAPTER 307.

AN ACT to amend 129.05 (1) of the statutes, relating to definition of transient merchant.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

129.05 (1) of the statutes is amended to read: 129.05 (1) A transient merchant is one who engages in the sale of merchandise at any place in this state temporarily, and who does not intend to become and does not become a permanent merchant of such place. No person shall engage in the business of transient merchant, without a license authorizing him to do so. For purposes of this section, sale of merchandise includes sales in which the personal services rendered upon or in connection with, such merchandise, constitutes the greatest part of value given for the price received.
