## CHAPTER 336.

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 301.245 of the statutes, relating to transferring cases from justice court.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

301.245 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

301.245 REMOVAL TO OTHER COURT. In counties having a population of less than 500,000, and in which a small claims court or a civil, municipal, superior or county court empowered to exercise civil jurisdiction has been established, the defendant in any action brought in justice court may, on the return day of the process, transfer the cause to the small claims court or to such civil, municipal, superior or county court of said county. Upon receipt of such a request, accompanied by a fee of 75 cents, the justice shall forthwith transmit all the papers in such cause to the clerk of said court of said county.
