CHAPTER 368.

- AN ACT to amend 85.44 (6) and to create 85.44 (10) of the statutes, relating to pedestrian traffic upon the highway, and authorizing municipalities to enact ordinances regarding the same, and providing a penalty.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 85.44 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.44 (6) Pedestrians using those highways not provided with sidewalks shall travel on and along the left side of such highway and the pedestrian, upon meeting a vehicle shall, if practicable, step * * * to the extreme outer limit of the traveled portion of the highway.

SECTION 2. 85.44 (10) of the statutes is created to read:

85.44 (10) LOCAL CONTROL. Cities of the first, second and third classes may enact ordinances regulating traffic of pedestrians upon highways.
