## CHAPTER 370.

AN ACT to amend 59.08 (22) of the statutes, relating to populous counties appropriating money for group entertainment of children on Halloween.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.08 (22) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.08 (22) Any county may appropriate money to defray the expense of municipal commemorative or patriotic eelebrations or observance or of state or national conventions of war veterans or of national conventions of fraternal associations, or in counties of a population of 500,000 or more, of group entertainment for children on Halloween by county or municipal agencies within the county.
