CHAPTER 438.

AN ACT to renumber 253.03 to be 253.03 (1); and to create 253.03 (2) and (3) of the statutes, relating to jurisdiction of county courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 253.03 of the statutes is renumbered to be 253.03 (1).

SECTION 2. 253.03 (2) and (3) of the statutes are created to read:

253.03 (2) The county court shall have concurrent jurisdiction to hear, try and determine all matters and controversies which may arise between any personal representative, guardian or trustee appointed by such court and any other person relating to title to or interest in real and personal property so far as such matter or controversy is incidental to and necessary for the complete administration of the estate, guardianship or trust, and regardless of who has possession of the property or in whose name it may be, to the same extent and with like effect as such matters and controversies may be heard, tried and determined in courts of general jurisdiction.

(3) Subsection (2) shall not affect the provisions of chapters 313 and 319 relating to debts of or claims against decedents or persons under guardianship.
