CHAPTER 442.

AN ACT to amend section 1 of chapter 213, laws of 1949, relating to leasing or selling the present executive mansion.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1 of chapter 213, laws of 1949, is amended to read:

SECTION 1 (Chapter 213, Laws of 1949). The bureau of engineering in the executive department is authorized and directed to *lease*, or offer for sale * * *, * * * contract for sale or sell in the name of the state the present executive mansion located at 130 East Gilman Street in the city of Madison, together with the lands surrounding the same owned by the state. Such sale shall not be made unless the highest price offered and accepted therefor shall equal or exceed \$47,500. No such lease shall be executed until the terms thereof and rental therefor have been approved by the governor. Upon completion of a sale in accordance with this section and payment of the purchase price and approval by the governor, the state chief engineer shall convey the same to the purchaser in the name of the state.
