CHAPTER 446.

AN ACT to renumber 12.15 to be 12.15 (1) and to create 12.15 (2) of the statutes, relating to the rate of charge for political advertising.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 12.15 of the statutes is renumbered to be 12.15 (1) of the statutes. SECTION 2. 12.15 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

12.15 (2) No person or corporation, within the state, publishing a newspaper or other periodical or operating a radio station or network of stations shall receive for political advertising or for political broadcasts, a rate in excess of the rate or rates regularly charged by such person or corporation for commercial advertising or for commercial broadcasts of similar character and classification and no candidate or political committee shall pay for political advertising or broadcasts any rate or charge in excess of such rate or rates regularly charged.
