CHAPTER 499.

AN ACT to amend 20.49 (8) (b) of the statutes, relating to highway aids and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.49 (8) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.49 (8) (b) The payments provided under paragraph (a) shall not be made until such time as the town *clerk or chairman*, or city or village clerk has filed with the commission his * * * *certification* stating that the town, city or village has complied with the provisions of section 40.895 requiring the marking of school zones and that such markings are presently in good condition. Such * * * *certification* shall set forth the names of the schools within the municipality where markings have been made and are being maintained. If it shall be found that the municipality has omitted to properly mark any school zones within its boundaries, \$25 shall be deducted from the money payable under the provisions of paragraph (a) for each school omitted.
