CHAPTER 522.

AN ACT to amend 340.70 (6) of the statutes, relating to regulation of fireworks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

340.70 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

340.70 (6) Under no circumstances shall any person sell, keep for sale, manufacture or bring into this state for use therein any fire balloon, mortars or excepting mortars used for special display purposes, cannon, or any explosive cane, toy pistol, toy revolver or other contrivance using explosive caps or cartridges, any Chinese firecrackers more than 2 inches in length or more than three-eighths inch in diameter, outside measurements of container, or any article containing a compound of mercury or yellow phosphorus.
