CHAPTER 589.

AN ACT to amend 351.30 (2) of the statutes, to make uniform the law relating to abandonment of child or wife.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

351.30 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

351.30 (2) Proceedings under this section may be instituted upon complaint made under oath or affirmation by the wife or child or children, or either of them, the superintendent or acting superintendent or other officer in charge of public welfare agencies, the director of the department of public welfare or case work supervisor II, or by any other person or persons, or organization, against any person guilty of either of the abovenamed offenses.
