CHAPTER 590.

AN ACT to renumber 59.999 (created by chapter 212, Laws of 1949) to be Chapter 254, Small Claims Court, and to create 59.07 (28) of the statutes relating thereto.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 59.999 of the statutes (created by chapter 212, Laws of 1949) is renumbered to be Chapter 254 and entitled "Small Claims Court"; subsections (1) to (31) of 59.999 are renumbered 254.01 to 254.31; the paragraphs thereof are made subsections; the subdivisions are made paragraphs; the words "this chapter" are substituted for "this section" and "this act"; and the statute references are changed to harmonize with this renumbering—all for the more logical location of the small claims court charter and for facilitating indexing, eiting and amending the provisions thereof, but without any substantive change in the law.

SECTION 2. 59.07 (28) of the statutes is created to read: 59.07 (28) SMALL CLAIMS COURT FOR COUNTY. In any county having a population of less than 500,000, determine by resolution, adopted by a majority vote of all its members-elect, the need therefor and make provision for the operation and maintenance of the small claims court created by chapter 254 of the statutes.
