**CHAPTER 629.**

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 37.12 of the statutes, relating to courses of study in state teachers colleges.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

37.12 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

37.12 COLLEGE COURSES. The board of normal school regents may extend the course of instruction at any teachers college to include a 4-year college liberal arts course. The board shall have the power to confer upon persons completing the 4-year course such degrees as are usual in universities and colleges.
