## CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT to amend 10.04 (1) of the statutes, relating to board of election commissioners' appointment of election officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

10.04 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

10.04 (1) Such board of election commissioners shall, during the month of January, 1920, and during the same month biennially thereafter, appoint 3 qualified voters as inspectors of election for each precinct in said cities. They shall be citizens of the United States; shall be of good repute and character; able to read and write the English language; be of good understanding and capable. They must reside in the ward for which they are selected to act and be entitled to vote therein at the next election, and not hold any other public office or employment, notary public excepted, and shall not be candidates for any public office while acting as such inspectors of election. The elected ward committeemen of each of the 3 dominant political parties as shown by the returns of the last preceding general election shall certify to the board of election commissioners a list containing the names of not less than \* \* 4 qualified voters for each such position in such ward and one of the persons whose names are so certified by the respective ward committeemen shall be appointed as inspectors by said board.
