CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to amend 85.40 (4) (a) of the statutes, relating to acceptance of bail for speed violators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.40 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.40 (4) (a) The sheriff, chief of police, or clerk of the court having jurisdiction of violations of this section is authorized to receive at his office from any person who shall have been accused of violation of this section or any county, city or village ordinance enacted by authority of chapter 85, and who has been arrested therefor, a deposit in money not to exceed the amount of the maximum penalty, the imposing of which in such case may be authorized, and to release such person from arrest until the opening of the court having jurisdiction of such violation on the next succeeding day when such court may be in session, or until a time which may be fixed for the hearing of the case.
