CHAPTER 222.

AN ACT to amend 49.40 (1) of the statutes, relating to supplementary health service to recipients of aid to the blind, aid to dependent children, and old-age assistance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

49.40 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

49.40 (1) The county agency administering aid to the blind, aid to dependent children, and old-age assistance may supplementary to such aids authorize and pay for medical, surgical, dental, hospital and nursing home care and optometrical services for recipients of such aids when necessary. A person shall be considered to be a recipient if at the time such care is authorized aid to the blind, aid to dependent children or old-age assistance is being granted to him. The provisions of section 49.11 shall not apply to this section.
